<b>5<sup>th</sup> March</b>	2.00pm to 4.15pm	What are 'tricks'. What are 'trumps'. The beginnings of bridge. You will leave this session able to play "MiniBridge".
<b>12<sup>th</sup> March</b>	2.00pm to 4.15pm	(Review of previous week from 1.30pm.) Move into playing bridge. Opening (starting) the bidding. Finding a fit in a Major suit (hearts or spades). Rules for raising partner's opening bids. What is 'game'. Learn when to bid 'game' or when to play a 'part-score'.
<b>19<sup>th</sup> March</b>	2.00pm to 4.15pm	(Review of previous week from 1.30pm.) Opening the bidding without a 5-card Major (clubs or diamonds). Rules for responding to partner's opening bids. Opener's second bid.
<b>26<sup>th</sup> March</b>	2.00pm to 4.15pm	(Review of previous week from 1.30pm..) Time to consolidate your learning: Less on bidding, more about some PLAY techniques.
